

#### Gut Microbiome in Low Back Pain Study – Instructions for Participants

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# (If you have fever, a new cough, or are having difficulty breathing, please contact us before collecting the sample)

In order to complete the study, you should have the following items:

- 1. A stool collection kit and a toilet accessory, marked with your name
- 2. A bio-specimen plastic bag
- 3. A stamped envelope

# **Collecting the stool sample**

[If you would like to see a video of the following instructions, please google "OM-200 instructions"] **IMPORTANT: Before collecting the stool sample please make sure that you use the kit** <u>with your</u> <u>name on it</u>.

- Wash your hands following the hand washing instructions before collecting the sample
- Empty your bladder before collecting the stool sample
- Place the toilet accessory on the toilet seat as illustrated in the brochure. Avoid any contact between the toilet accessory and water, urine or other liquids.
- If the sample comes into contact with water, urine or diarrhea wait for the next bowel movement.
- Open the OmniGene Gut 200 kit.
- Remove the purple cap from the tube (make sure you do NOT remove the yellow cap).
- Use the spatula to take a small amount of stool, and place it in the yellow tube-top. Do NOT push the sample into the tube. Repeat this until the yellow tube-top is full.
- Cap the tube with the purple top and seal tightly.
- Shake the tube using hard and fast motions for **30 seconds**.
- Place the tube in the plastic bag, and seal it.

## Filling-in the online questionnaire

- Please make sure that you fill-in the questionnaire on the same day that you collect the stool.

## Mailing the sample

- Wash your hands as per the instruction before preparing the package
- Please place the following in the attached envelope, labeled "Exempt Human Specimen":
  - $\circ~$  A stool samples in the bio-specimen plastic bag.
  - This form, containing the date of sample collection.
  - Any other samples and questionnaires which were included in this package.
- Place the envelope in any Canada Post letter box or office.
